Alvin August Arthur Quandt died at nearly 98 years of age in Bay St. Louis, MS on March 12, 2010. He was born May 8, 1912 in Grand Island, NB. He was a farmer, Owned and operated two sawmills and was in construction for most of his life. Alvin was called Bill in his later life. Alvin was in the United States Marine Corps in China during the 1030's. He was inducted into the United States Army during early WW11. While in the military, he won several medals as well, one for swimming the longest distance in the Mediterranean sea . Alvin is survived by his wife, Evangeline (Vangie) Quandt. They were married July 13, 1990 and settled in Bay St. Louis, MS, where they lost everything during hurricane Katrina. Vangie lovingly cared for him in their home until his death. Alvin had 10 children and was preceded in death by 3, William (Billy), Calvin and Sharon.

He survived by 1 son, Howard and 6 daughters, Gretchen, Peggy, Marjorie, Phyllis, Virginia, Sandra and a beloved daughter-in-law, Dorothy, as well as numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Alvin married his first wife, Mabel Pauline Currie in 1937. Together, they had the ten children.
