Alvin Bernard Krumrey, 97, of Commerce went to be with his lord on Sunday, June 17, 2018 at Windridge Care and Rehab. He was stationed in the South Pacific as a code clerk and truck driver. Upon returning home he became a Glazier. He was a member of the First Assembly of God in Commerce. Mr. Krumrey was preceded in passing by his wife Pauline Krumrey, a son Alvin Ray Krumrey, a grandson Joshua Easley, his first wife Lawanda Krumrey, a brother Theodore and two sisters Bertha and Alma.
