



Anthony "Tony" H. Wiseley

January 16, 1966 - March 4, 2016

Anthony "Tony" Hilton Wiseley, 50, of the Fairland area passed away on Friday, March 04, 2016 surrounded by his family. Tony was born on January 16, 1966 in Conway Arkansas to Archie Hilton and Mary Ann (Ballard) Wiseley. He joined the United States Marines and had a few tours to the Gulf. Tony moved to the Fairland area from Sallisaw to work as a Park Ranger in Bernice and Honey Creek along with being a patrolman with the Fairland Police Department. In 1995 in Fairland Tony married his wife of twenty years, Tina S. Hughes. He worked at Fairland for twenty plus years and was currently their Chief. He also worked for the Eastern Shawnee Tribe at their Police Chief. He spent time at Moccasin Bend and Willowcrest and was the head of security at Downstream Casino at one time and worked security at Buffalo Run Casino too. As Mr. Wiseley made Fairland his home he got on the Fairland Volunteer Fire Department and was a paramedic. Tony was proud to be a servant of his community, but, the thing he was most proud of was his family, he enjoyed going to their ball games and track meets. Tony and Tina are members of the First Assembly of God in Fairland. Mr. Wiseley was preceded in passing by his parents Archie and Mary Ann Wiseley.

Survivors include his wife Tina Wiseley of the home, his children; Toni BreAnn Wiseley of Tulsa, Zachary Needham of Peoria, Oklahoma, Mahala Wiseley and Miranda Wiseley both of Fairland, his sisters Michelle Burnside of Miami and Dee Stubblefield of Stigler, Oklahoma, a grandson Jude Hilton Needham

along with other relative and close friends.

Visitation will be on Monday, March 7, 2016 at the Fairland School Gym from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM.

Services are 2:00 PM Tuesday, March 8, 2016 also at the Fairland School Gym with Reverend Jackie Crafton and Reverend Jerry Jones officiating. Interment will follow at the Fairland Cemetery under the care of the Brown-Winters Funeral Home and Cremation Service. The American Legion Post #147 will be providing funeral honors and local police officers have the high honor of casket watch and will stand vigil until services are complete.

The family has asked that memorial contributions be made to the Wiseley family to help with expenses of services and medical expenses from Tony's long battle.
