February 10, 1925 - January 25, 2024

Ava Maxine Billups, 98, a longtime Miami resident passed away at her home on Thursday, January 25, 2024. She was born on February 10, 1925, in Bluejacket, Oklahoma to Stephen and Lena Charlotte (Kamp) Schultz. Maxine went to a one room school in Bluejacket, her and her siblings then went to Afton High School for the remainder of the schooling. She enrolled in Accounting College in Miami which prompted Delbert Billups, her boyfriend at the time, to marry her, so she never attended. They married on September 14, 1942, in Afton. She and Delbert lived in Miami for many years, she was in a CB club in Miami and her handle was "Doodle Bug". Maxine was grandma to anyone the grandkids brought home. Mrs. Billups was preceded in passing by her parents, her husband Delbert Billups, her son Steven Billups, her siblings Bertha Gamble, Claire Speer, Clyde Schultz, and Betty Stevenson.

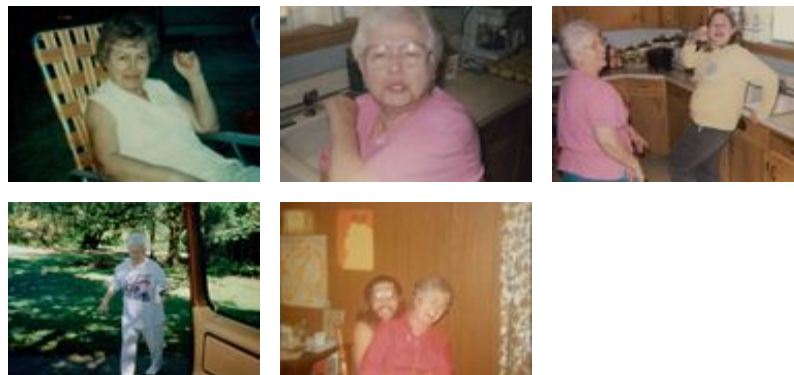
