



Bernice "Bernie" Barnes

January 19, 1916 - August 10, 2011

Longtime Miami resident Mrs. Bernice V. Barnes passed into eternity peacefully surrounded by family on Wednesday morning August 10, 2011 in Commerce, Oklahoma at the age of 95.

Bernice was born in Watford City, North Dakota to her parents Carl and Loucille Shellabarger on January 10, 1916. Always one for adventure, Bernie moved West to Oregon where she met and married Fred R. Doney on February 20th, 1939 in Redding, California. Together they had two sons, Thomas R. Doney and Jack R.
