



Bert Tyson Eubanks

October 26, 1923 - July 5, 2012

TYSON EUBANKS Bert "Tyson" Eubanks of Afton, Oklahoma passed from this life on July 5 at St. Francis Medical Center in Tulsa. Memorial service will be held at Trinity Southern Baptist Church in Afton on Monday, July 9 at 10:00 a.m. Visitation will be Sunday evening 6:00-8:00 pm at the Trinity Southern Baptist Church, Afton. Tyson Eubanks was born October 26, 1923 to Barber and Mabel (Vaughn) Eubanks at Plainview, Texas. He graduated from Dimmitt High School in 1941 and attended Texas Tech for three semesters before enlisting in the United States Marine Corps. He participated in the invasion and occupation of Peleliu and Okinawa and the liberation of China. Following his honorable discharge, he continued his education at Texas Tech where he was president of the Ag Club when it became Alpha Zeta. He graduated in January of 1949 and returned to Dimmitt to engage in farming and teaching in the Veterans Vocational Agriculture Program. On July 31, 1949, he married Bobbie Ruth Boynton of Greensburg, Kansas, and purchased farm land near Bovina, Texas. In the fall of 1952, Tyson and family moved to their farm northeast of Afton. Tyson was a rancher his entire life and was passionate about converting cultivated land into permanent pasture. He worked briefly in the Craig County Assessor's office and taught seventh grade science in Vinita Junior High until his retirement in 1985. He was a charter member of Trinity Southern Baptist Church of Afton. He is survived by his wife, Bobbie; his daughter Barbara Eubanks of Independence, Kansas, his son (Robert) Bob Eubanks and wife Kay of Welch, six grandchildren, and eleven great-

grandchildren and brother Oren and wife Joyce. He was preceded in death by his son Kent in July 1985. Memorials can be made to Oklahoma Baptist Boys Ranch of Edmond, Oklahoma.
