



## Betty Jean Crafton

August 28, 1944 - October 13, 2024

Betty Jean Crafton, 80, a longtime Fairland Educator passed away at Hillcrest South Hospital in Tulsa on Sunday, October 13, 2024. Betty was born in Fairland on August 28, 1944, to William Collis “Brownie” and Jessie Elizabeth (Goodman) Crafton. Betty graduated from Fairland High School, then went to Northeastern Oklahoma A&M College for her Associate’s, attained her Bachelor’s Degree and Master’s Degree from Northeastern State University in Tahlequah. While at Tahlequah she attended Chi Alpha which often traveled and sang at many churches. She would still get together at times with members of that group. She started her teaching career at Vinita, then Afton before landing at Fairland for twenty-six years. She mostly taught grade school and then reading. She loved kids and was even a cheer sponsor when she was needed. She was a member of the First Assembly of God in Fairland all her life. She loved her church family. Betty would make cookies for the youth often when she was able. Betty’s parents Brownie and Jessie Crafton preceded her in passing along with her siblings Ronnie Crafton, Jerry Lynn Crafton and Don Crafton, along with a niece Sheila Lockhart.
