“ *Fond memories*

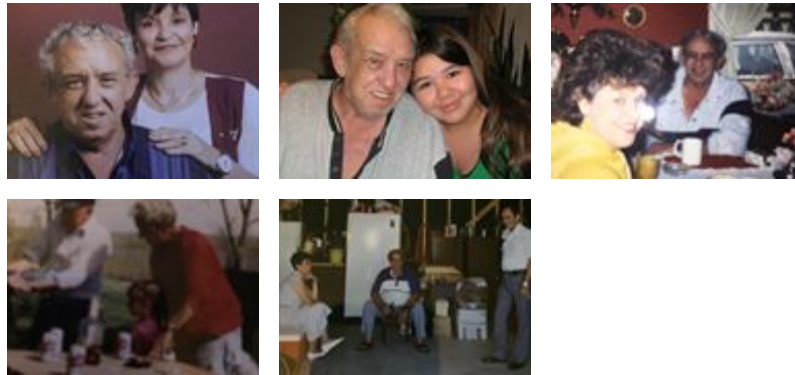
