Bobby Glen Garrett, 76, a longtime Miami area resident, passed away on Monday, March 2, 2026, at Hillcrest Medical Center in Tulsa. Bobby was born on July 1, 1949, in Chelsea, Oklahoma, to John Henry and Eda (Bowlin) Garrett. Bobby's family soon moved to the Afton area, where the kids finished school. Bobby married Linda Mason on January 30, 1970, which was also the year he was drafted into the US Army, where he served proudly. When Mr. Garrett returned from the military deployment, he began working at the Baxter Co-op, where he worked until his retirement. Of course, he went on to work at Farmland in Afton, delivering feed. He farmed for many years. He was baptized at the Afton First Baptist Church but was a member of the Hudson Creek Baptist Church for many years.
