Braydon Parker Scott was born November 12, 1997 in Claremore, Oklahoma. He passed away at his home on Sunday, April 23, 2017. He was nineteen. Braydon's parents are Weston Scott and Catherine (Linn) and Brian Sparks. Braydon was attending First Assembly of God in Commerce; he had a tremendous love for God and exhibited that love in the way he lived his life. Braydon loved to make people happy, loved college and all different types of music. Braydon had worked for three years at Microtel in Miami where his co-workers/friends invited him to attend his church. He graduated Miami High School with the class of 2016; he was attending NEO A&M College with aspirations of becoming a registered nurse specifically working in pediatric rehabilitation. Braydon was preceded in passing by his maternal grandfather, Lonnie Linn.

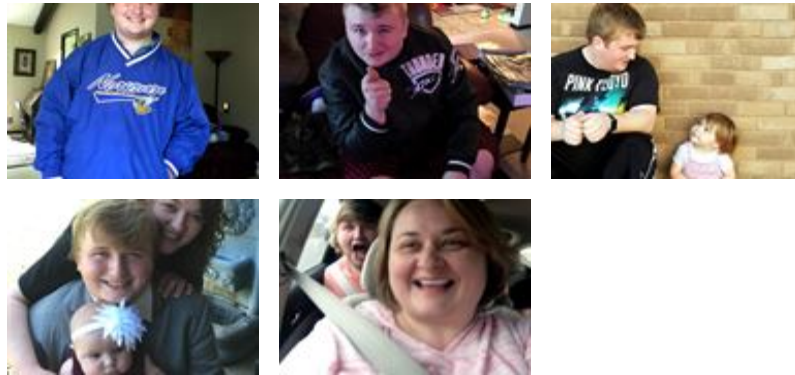
