Carl Dean Cheatwood was born on September 6, 1944 in Micawber, Oklahoma to James C. and Elizabeth Akin Cheatwood. He grew up fishing and hunting with his five brothers, three sisters and two cousins on farms near Okemah where large family dinners were a beloved tradition.

Carl joined the Army Reserves and went to basic training at Fort Bragg, LA.

After moving to Miami, he worked the “graveyard shift” building heavy duty tires at BF Goodrich for 18 years. In 1973 Carl married his wife Marilyn and gained 3 daughters he loved dearly. The family spent many special days swimming, skiing and camping at the Lake. Carl coached his girls’ Little Americans softball team. He played 1st base in the First Baptist slow pitch league. He loved to bird and deer hunt especially with his nephews and brothers. Many will remember the 1956 Chevy pickup he restored.

Carl was preceded in death by his parents and four brothers.

He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Marilyn, three daughters Denise Lingo (John), Micki Ward (Tim) and Michelle Naylor (Brian), sister-in-law Marla Heydt (Tim), his brother Don and three sisters, Betty, Maggie and MaryAnn, many nieces and nephews and was Papa to 10 grandchildren.

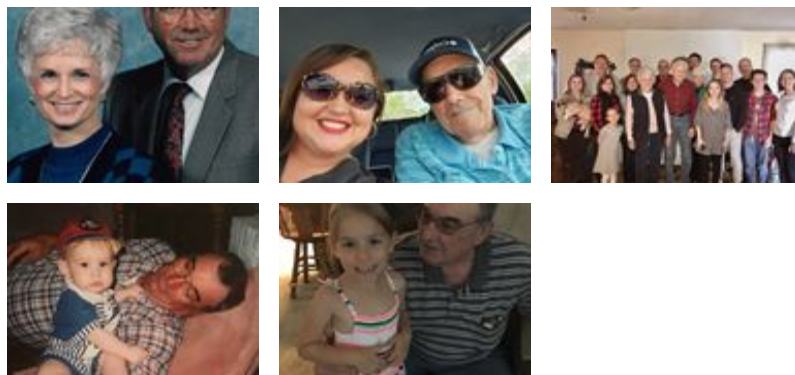
