



## Carl G. Schenk

October 4, 1938 - February 5, 2022

Carl G. Schenk, 83, a longtime Miami resident, passed away Saturday, February 5, 2022. He was born on October 4, 1938 in Bluejacket, Oklahoma to Carl and Hazel (Hency) Schenk.

After his graduation from Bluejacket, Carl joined the Army Reserves. He married Shirley (Cox) in June of 1973. Carl worked for BF Goodrich as a tire builder for a number of years here in Miami and Alabama. He and Shirley moved back to Miami after his retirement.
