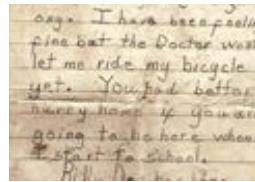
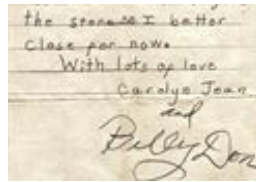
GOD will always be with Carolyn to take care of her, she loved our LORD so much , all of her friends, grandkids, kids, great grandkids have lived better lives because of her.
