



## Clyde Dale DePriest

July 13, 1938 - January 7, 2024

Clyde Dale DePriest, 85, a long-time resident of Wyandotte, Oklahoma, passed away at his home on Sunday, January 7, 2024. Dale was born on July 13, 1938, in Stella, Missouri, to Homer and Frances (Francisco) DePriest. Dale graduated from Goodman High School with the Class of 1956. Dale married Carolyn Hathaway on September 12, 1956. Together they would have four children. They were separated by her passing in June of 1992. He would later marry Shirley Chidester on August 22, 1998. Dale will always be known for his strong work ethic and rich friendships. He would be seen leaving before daylight and getting home after dark. He started his career with Foremost delivering eggs. He would later be promoted to deliver milk and sometimes ice cream across the four-state area. He retired from Foremost Foods as a Regional Director. After that he was hired and worked in Management for Hiland Dairies of Joplin, Mo. After retiring again Dale decided to start DePriest Farms, where he raised “Broilers” for Simmons, Hudson, and Tyson Foods. When he wasn’t working he enjoyed attending the ATA Lodge in Perseverance, Missouri with Shirley and friends where he served as President for twenty-two years. He also enjoyed raising livestock, hunting, and fishing with family and friends, as well as taking trips to Branson and fishing trips to Canada in recent years.
