



Corbett C. Bowden

December 7, 1920 - April 24, 2011

Longtime resident of Miami Mr. Corbett C. Bowden went home to be with his heavenly father on Sunday April 24, 2011 in Miami at the age of 90 years. Corbett was born December 7, 1920 to his parents Minor and Jewell Bowden in Miami, Oklahoma.

Corbett owned and operated Bowden Radiator Service in Miami from 1946-1970. He and Virginia married September 26, 1944 in Miami, Oklahoma. He and Virginia were longtime and dedicated members of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Corbett worked for the Spartan School of Aeronautics as an aircraft mechanic from 1941-1945. Corbett enjoyed fishing and gardening. He was known to the family as a true fix-it man. Corbett could fix anything that was set in his path. He also enjoyed taking pictures and videos.
