



Dennis Dean Fisher

August 12, 1940 - May 18, 2019

Dennis Dean Fisher, a seventy-eight year old Afton resident passed away on Saturday, May 18, 2019 at St. John Medical Center in Tulsa. Dean was born on August 12, 1940 in rural Delaware County to Wilton L. and Lillian Francis (Mustain) Fisher. Mr. Fisher graduated from Oklahoma State University with a Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture Education. He farmed and ranched in the Afton area for most of his life. He married the love of his life on November 23, 1963, Ethel Marlene Reynolds. Dean was a member of the United States Army National Guard. In 1984, he sold his dairy cattle, and continued to raise crops and beef cattle while working for the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority. After retiring from the OTA, he worked at Precision Machine in Grove. He and Marlene are longtime members of Trinity Southern Baptist church in Afton, where he was a dedicated Deacon for many years, and taught the Adult Sunday School Class for fifty-three consecutive years. Dean had also served for twelve years on the Afton Board of Education from 1972 to 1984. Dean enjoyed hunting, fishing and woodworking; making several pieces of furniture that he has share with his family and his church. He also raised a big garden every year and he enjoyed making picante sauce, jelly and pickles. Mr. Fisher was preceded in passing by his parents Wilton and Lillian Fisher.

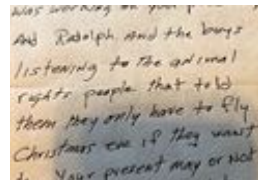
