Donald T. Babst, 80, a lifetime Fairland resident passed away at Grand Lake Villa in Grove on Friday, May 31, 2013. Don was born on September 4, 1932 in Fairland to Theodore Otto and Charlotte Louise "Lottie" (Schnarre) Babst. He graduated with an Associate in Agriculture from Northeastern Oklahoma A&M. His first wife Maxine (Reed) Babst preceded him in passing December 20, 1971. Mr. Babst worked for B.F. Goodrich for thirty-one years, he and his brother also had the Babst Auction Service for sixteen years and he worked as a realtor for Hazel Weber, Walter Cobb and Susan Rhodes.
