



Donald "Don" Leroy Crafton

April 25, 1956 - August 19, 2014

Donald Leroy "Don" Crafton, a lifetime resident and business owner of Fairland Oklahoma, passed away at his home in rural Fairland on Tuesday, August 19, 2014. Don was born on April 25, 1956 in Miami, Oklahoma to William Collis "Brownie" and Jessie Elizabeth (Goodman) Crafton. He was a Graduate of Fairland High School Class of 1974 and was a member of the 1970 State Champion football team at Fairland. Don worked for his parents at Crafton Station all his life until 1987 when he purchased the business from them and continued on in their footsteps by providing a great service for the community. In 1980 he was awarded the AgService Safemark Dealer of the month for his service to the member program for Ottawa County Farm Bureau members. Don was also the recipient of the Oklahoma Honorary State FFA Degree from the state FFA Association, which is the highest honor an adult citizen can receive, and proudly supported all local FFA organizations and schools. He enjoyed watching football and westerns in his free time along with family get togethers on 4th of July and Christmas at his home. He loved spoiling his nieces and nephews with fireworks and presents along with helping anyone in need. Don was preceded in passing by his mother, father and infant siblings, three brothers and one sister.

Survivors include his sister Betty Crafton of Fairland, brother William "Bud" Crafton II. and his wife Diane of Tupelo, Mississippi, sister Mary "Cathy" Lockhart and her husband Larry of Tulsa, brother James "Jim" Crafton and his wife Dorothy of Fairland and sister Patricia "Patty" Hays and her husband Sonny of Broken Arrow. Other survivors include his six nieces and nephews, William Collis Crafton III, Sheila Lockhart, Tonya Reynolds, Tim Crafton, Tiffany Butts and Patrick Hays, and eleven great nieces and nephews William Collis III, Brennan and Amber Crafton, Jesse and Jimmie Lockhart, Caleb, Kyla, and Caden Reynolds, Logan and Kiara Crafton, Brelynn and Hoyt Butts along with a host of other family members.
