Donald “Donnie” Eugene Fields age 67, resident of Fairland, Oklahoma, went to be his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, surrounded by his wife and sons. Donnie was a member of The First Assembly of God in Fairland, Oklahoma, where he was active with the men’s ministry, jail ministry, a beloved van driver, and sponsor of the Alive Youth Group. Donnie graduated with the class of 1976, in Grove, Oklahoma, where he affectionately referred to it as “Grove University”. 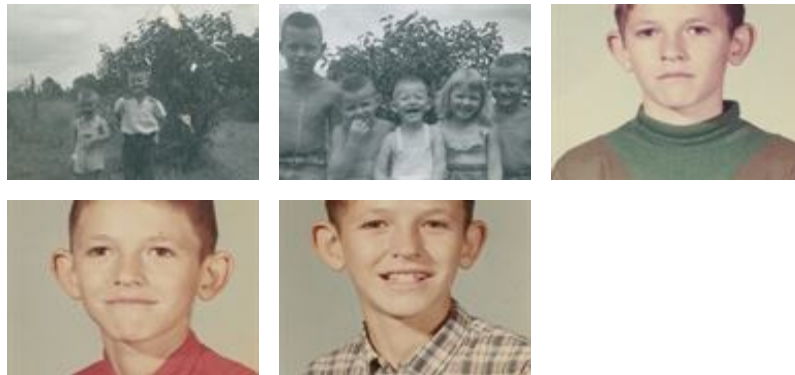

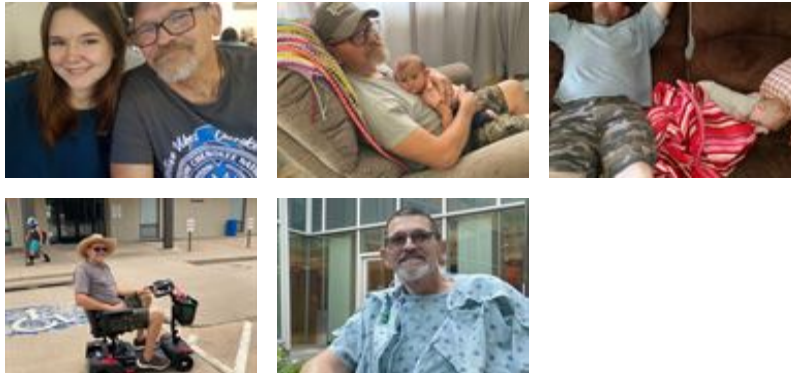
