Donald Leroy Williams, 81, a resident of Bluejacket, Oklahoma, passed away surrounded by family at his home on Sunday, July 13, 2025. 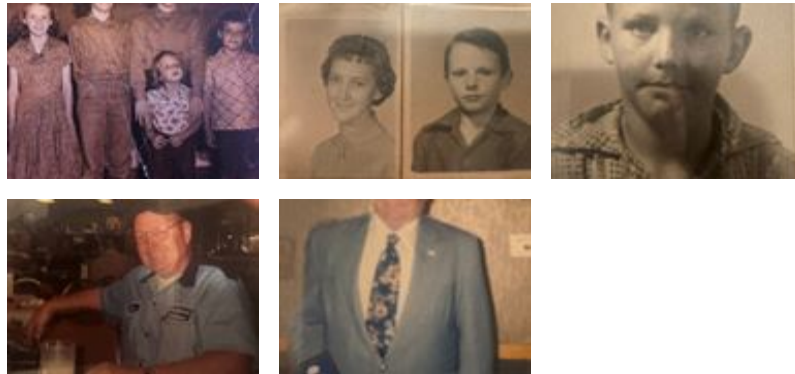
