DOROTHY BOONE BOTTS; LEFT US PEACEFULLY ON JULY 31, 2011.

A MEMBER OF THE ONEIDA TRIBE OF WISCONSIN. BORN IN RENO, NEVADA TO WALKER LANE BOONE AND MALINDA HOUSE BOONE. DECEMBER 31, 1915. SHE LIVED AT STEWART, NEVADA WHERE HER FATHER WAS CHIEF CLERK OF THE INDIAN AGENCY AND SCHOOL. SHE MOVED TO SENECA INDIAN SCHOOL AT WYANDOTTE, OKLAHOMA IN AUGUST, 1925. SHE ATTENDED GRADE SCHOOL AND GRADUATED HIGH SCHOOL 1933. WHILE LIVING AT SENECA INDIAN SCHOOL WHERE HER MOTHER MALINDA BOONE WAS EMPLOYED. SHE ATTENDED NEO. JR. COLLEGE IN MIAMI, OKLAHOMA WHERE SHE MET ELLSWORTH "BUD" BOTTS. THEY WERE MARRIED JUNE 26, 1935. HE PASSED AWAY DECEMBER 16, 1994. DURING THE YEARS SHE BELONGED TO MANY SOCIAL CLUBS WHICH INCLUDED AAUW MOTHER'S CLUB AND BOOK REVIEW CLUB. ALSO WOMEN'S PILOT CLUB, MIAMI CHAPTER OF EASTERN STAR AS A STARPOINT, CHAPLIN & MUSICIAN. SHE WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE WHITE SHRINE, MOTHER ADVISOR OF RAINBOW ASSEMBLY OF GIRLS. MIAMI, OKLAHOMA. PAST PRESIDENT OF AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY. AT NEO A & M SHE WAS A MEMBER OF THE SORORITY BETA UPSILON. SHE WORKED WITH BUD AND FAMILY OPERATING BOTTS WHOLESALE COMPANY AND AS A CO-OWNER UNTIL THEY SOLD

THE BUSINESS 1977. SHE AND BUD WERE MEMBERS OF THE FIRST CHRISTIAN CHURCH IN MIAMI, OKLAHOMA FOR MANY YEARS. AFTER BUD PASSED AWAY SHE MOVED TO BROKEN ARROW IN JUNE 1995 TO LIVE WITH HER DAUGHTER DOTTIE AND HER HUSBAND RICHARD. IN MARCH 2007 SHE MOVED TO THE VILLAGE HEALTH CARE CENTER IN BROKEN ARROW WHERE SHE RESIDED UNTIL HER DEATH.
