Douglas Wayne James, 67, a resident of Miami, Oklahoma, passed away on Monday, May 19th, 2025, at his home. He was born in Heidelberg, Germany on July 2nd, 1957, to Francis R James and Lora Ellen (Ferrell) James. Doug graduated from Welch High School, Class of 1975, and went on to serve his country in the United States Marine Corps. On August 25, 1991, he married Tammy Kropp McCleary in a ceremony in Miami, OK. Doug worked at Integris Hospital in Miami as a Nuclear Medicine Technician for 40 years.
