Dustin Ray Eby, born on November 23rd, 1982, suddenly passed away on April 11th 2026, at the age of 43. Dustin is survived by his daughters Rayleigh Jeanette Eby and Adaleigh Ray Eby, His Best friend and mother to his children Crystal Eby, His Father Tommy and Dana Eby, Sister Tiffany and Eric Whitaker, Sister Brittany and Anthony Combs, Sister Kasi and James McCully, Sister Kelci Anderson and Jon Logan, His grandmother Lawanda Eby, along with many more family and friends.
