Edith Fay (Meister) Essex, 84-year-old Lifetime area resident, passed away Wednesday, August 22, 2018 in Wyandotte, Oklahoma.

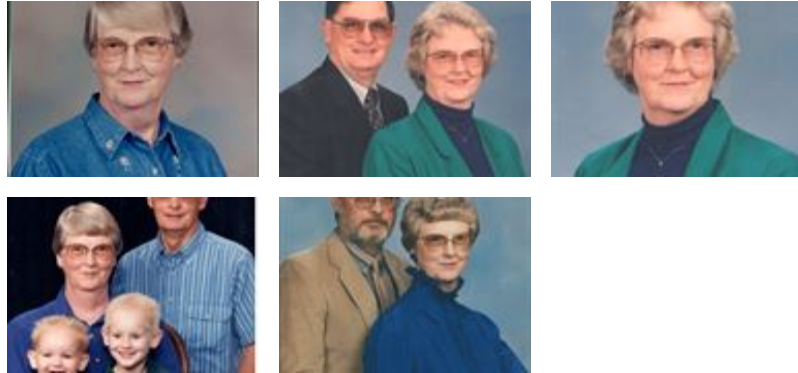
