Elizabeth Louise LoMonaco passed from this life on June 15th, 2025 at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Elizabeth was born on December 18, 1931 in Streator, Illinois to the late Frank and Louise Kapraun.

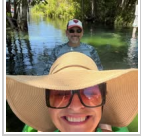
