Join the family of Florence Mears Tromsness on Saturday, May 23rd, at 1 pm, for her Celebration of Life at Commerce First Assembly of God, Commerce, Oklahoma, with Reverend Howie Moss officiating. There will be a private family burial at Glen-Abbey Memorial Garden following.

Florence was born in St. Paul, Minnesota, to Norman and Marjorie Mears on October 14, 1935. She graduated from Sioux Falls Baptist College, South Dakota, in 1957, and spent a year serving the Baptist Convention. She met her sweetheart, Clair, at SFC, and they married in August 1958. They then moved to Berkeley, California, to attend Berkeley Baptist Divinity School. Clair received his Bachelor's in Divinity in 1961 and a Master of Arts in Comp & Rhetoric from Stanford University in 1964, while Florence made a comfortable home for their young family, Shirley, Elizabeth, & David.

The family of 5 moved to Miami, Oklahoma, in 1964, where Clair taught English at NEO A&M Junior College for 20 years. Clair, Florence, & their children faithfully attended & ministered at Miami First Assembly of God for a number of years. They often hosted visiting missionaries in their home. Together, Clair & Florence helped lead the Christian Motorcycle Association (CMA) and opened the Miami Missionary Tent Company in 1980, as well as 3 Christian Bookstores in Miami (1972), Stillwater (1976), and Carthage (1981). Florence was heavily involved in ministry and community.

Florence had a full & active life in Miami, surrounded by many friends and her church family. She is survived by her 3 children: Shirley Rucker (Mark), Liz Mitchell (Scott), and David Tromsness (Chunlan). She has 6 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren.
