While in the Airforce he served as a Special Police Officer during Vietnam. He worked at Goodrich until its closing, then owned his own repair business before working Maintenance at J&M Farms. He served many years on the Funeral Honors Team with the American Legion and was also active placing flags in the community for Holidays.
