



## Geneva Pearl DeMier

December 24, 1915 - November 11, 2009

Longtime Miami resident, Mrs. Geneva Pearl DeMier passed from this life on Wednesday evening November 11, 2009 in Miami, Oklahoma at the age of 93 years.

Geneva was born December 24, 1915 to Dudley and Louise Lacy in Putnam, Oklahoma.
