Georgia Sparkle Hale, 88, a longtime Miami resident passed away at Saint Francis Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma. 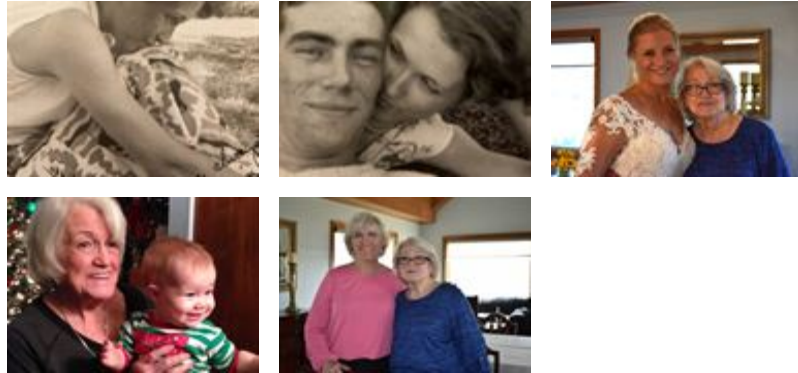
