Harold Mahan passed away in the hands of God Sunday evening March 13, at 5:30 PM at the home he built in 1961, surrounded by family. Harold was born December 30, 1923 in Stella, Missouri, the son of Loy and Ethel (Linton) Mahan. He graduated high school in Stella, Missouri, and then joined the Navy in 1944. He served in the Admiralty Islands, Philippines. He came back and married Glenna Jean (Cook) Mahan August 14, 1947. They celebrated their sixty-ninth wedding anniversary. Harold worked at B.F. Goodrich in Miami until her retired in 1984. He will be remembered for his caring and honest ways. Harold put everyone first including friends and family, grandkids, even people he didn't know. He referred to himself as "Granddad." He was well known for his artistry. He made some of the most beautiful wood carvings, specializing in Owls.
