Harriett Ann Klaus, 80, a longtime Afton resident passed away at a Tulsa Hospital on Sunday, March 12, 2017. Harriett was born on April 30, 1936 to Bert and May (Higgins) Brewster in Miami, Oklahoma. She attended Wyandotte High School and graduated in 1954, and also attended the Northeast Technology Center in Afton. She married Douglas Klaus on February 4, 1955 in Miami.
