Issic "Ike" Lee Lacy, 94, a lifelong resident of Miami, Oklahoma, passed away on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, at Mercy Hospital in Joplin, Missouri. 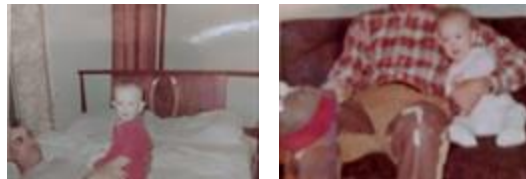

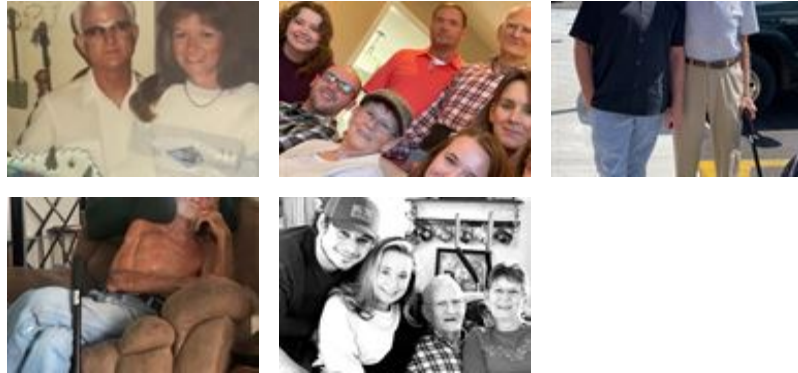
