John B. Dillon, 85, a longtime Miami resident, passed away on Thursday, September 17, 2020 at Integris Miami. Mr. Dillon was born on June 14, 1935, in Baxter Springs, Kansas, to Frank P. and Agnes (Carter) Dillon. John graduated with the Class of 1953 from Galena High School. On January 22, 1955, he married the love of his life, Sereta Friend. John worked at the B.F. Goodrich plant until his retirement there. He then worked at Ozark Salad until his retirement there; he then drove a school bus for Miami Public Schools until his retirement from there. He and Sereta were members of First Assembly of God Church in Miami and were very active through the years. Among his many services for the church, John served in the roles of Royal Ranger leader, Chi Alpha sponsor, Sunday School Superintendent for 20 years, and on the Trustee and the Deacon Board for numerous terms. One of John's duties about which he was most passionate was serving as the director for 20 years of the Green Country Youth Camp. He also took great pleasure in working as the potato peeler and the candy skillet carrier for church dinners and the missionary candy making project. Mr. Dillon is preceded in passing by his parents Frank and Agnes Dillon, and one sister Lois Lewis.

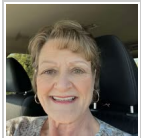

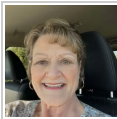
