Kathryn Ann Dickerson passed December 7, 2015 at Higher Call Nursing Center after a long illness. She was born on October 11, 1954 in Miami, Oklahoma to Wayne and Twila (Kleffman) Dickerson. She was baptized and confirmed into the Lutheran Faith at Mount Olive Lutheran Church.
