Kenneth Wayne Blalock, 71, a resident of Miami passed away at his home on Saturday, February 4, 2017. Mr. Blalock graduated with the Miami High School Class of 1964, he then attended Bible College in Lincoln, Illinois where he received a Biblical Literature Degree, he then attended Pitt State University his Masters Degree and Teaching Certificate. Kenny worked as a teacher for twenty-nine years he retire while teaching at Baxter Springs Elementary, after retirement he worked as a substitute teacher for twelve and a half years. 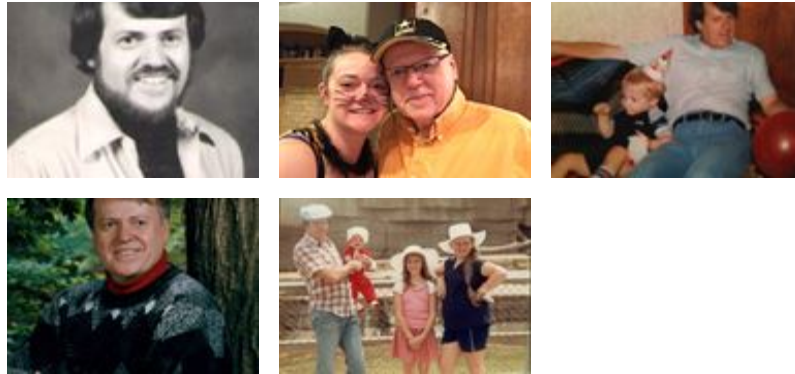
