



## Kenneth James Nodine

Kenneth James Nodine, 81, of Fairland passed away at his home on Tuesday, June 6, 2017.

Kenneth was born December 14, 1935 in Washburn, MO, the son of Joseph and Elsie (Lawrence) Nodine.

He spent his early years growing up on Mike's Creek near Powell, MO. He graduated from Rocky Comfort High School. He later furthered his education by taking night courses in electronics, drafting and mechanical engineering.
