Lellous "Harold" McGuire, aged 72, a cherished resident of Bluejacket, Oklahoma, passed away peacefully at his home on Tuesday, January 28, 2025. Harold was born on September 14, 1952, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma to the loving parents, L.K. McGuire and Betty Lou (Linscott) Wheatley.

He had a long career as a Maintenance Technician. He worked for a package company in Joplin, where his expertise and dedication to his craft earned him respect and admiration from his colleagues. He had also worked as an over the road truck driver and in maintenance at NEO A&M College.

One of their proudest achievements was training one of their Blood Hounds to become the first certified drug dog of its kind at the time. Harold and Sharon utilized both Labs and Blood Hounds in their training efforts, making significant contributions to public safety.

Harold's life was filled with love, dedication, and service. He was preceded in passing by his father, L.K. McGuire.

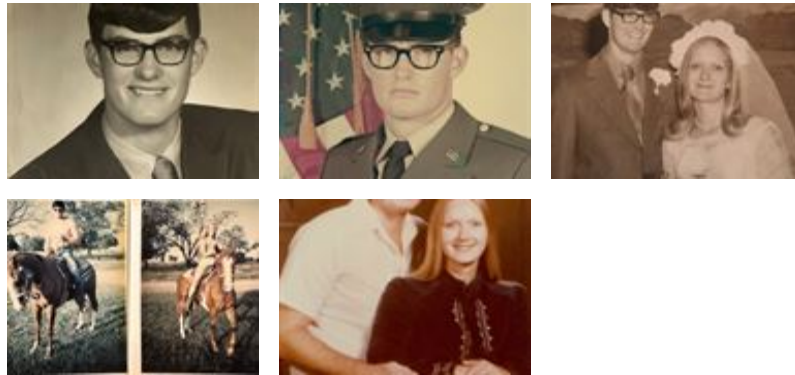
