Loren Don "Rainbo" Hale, 90, of Miami, passed away on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 at Mercy Hospital in Joplin, Missouri. Mr. Hale was born on August 28, 1926 in Stark City, Missouri to Guy M. and Lela Frances (Moore) Hale. He graduated from Midway High School, and then joined the United States Army; he was a drill Sergeant where he was stationed in Arkansas. He then married his wife of sixty-nine years on December 10, 1946 at the Methodist Church in Miami. Rainbo worked at B.F. Goodrich where he retired as a Foreman. Throughout those years he was recognized for donating 20 gallons of Blood through the American Red Cross. He and Thomasine were members of Northwest Baptist Church. Rainbo enjoyed fishing, hunting and camping; he worked with Jay Weaver haying for years and then went to work with Art Cousatte.
