



## Lynn H Vanderham

April 30, 1930 - April 2, 2014

Lynn H Vanderham, 83, a resident of Miami passed away on Wednesday April 2, 2014 at his home. He was born on April 30, 1930 in Everett Washington to Lynn H. and Althea Marie (McCaulley) Vanderham . Lynn joined the United States Navy in August of 1946; he retired after thirty years of service as Chief Hospital Corpsman. He was employed in Various Medically related positions associated with National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Lockheed Shipbuilding Corp and a Staff Officer in the U.S. Merchant Marine. He also served as Bailiff for the Oregon State Supreme Court. His last employment was Manager of Central Supply Department at Salem Hospital in Salem Oregon. After moving back to Oklahoma Mr. Vanderham worked at Locke Supply and at Wal-Mart. Lynn was preceded in passing by his parents Lynn and Althea along with a brother Donnie McCaulley.
