Mary Elizabeth Manning, 71 year old, Miami, Oklahoma resident passed away, Wednesday April 4, 2018 following a sudden illness.

Mary was born on April 6th 1946 in Lebanon, Missouri to Carl and Jane (Brassfield) Marshall. After high school Mary attended the Barge school of Nursing in Springfield, Missouri.
