Mary Ruth Spurgeon went to be with her lord on Thursday, December 1, 2016. She was born in Hartwell, Missouri on January 2, 1920. Her parents were Annie (McBride) Ayres and Loarn Ayres. Mary's mother passed when she was two years old. She was raised by her dad in Olathe, Kansas which was a small town at the time. She worked at Pratt Whitney during World War II. She also worked at Sunshine Biscuit Company and Bell Telephone in Kansas City. She then also worked at Griffin Food Company in Muskogee. After moving to Miami in 1954 she worked at the Miami Public Schools and then NEO A&M College retiring in 1989. She was a member of the First Christian Church in Miami. Spurgeon, her sister Opal Collins, a daughter Shirley Franklin, and two grandsons Robbie Franklin and Jim Collins.
