Mary J. Stotts, 78, a resident of Joplin, Missouri passed away at Freeman Health System in Joplin, on Tuesday, February 28, 2023. Mary was born on December 24, 1944, in Pittsburg, Kansas to Eugene and Della Sellars. Mary graduated from Southeast High School in Cherokee, Kansas in 1962. After raising a family, she attended the University of New Mexico Las Cruces where she graduated with a master's degree in Sociology. She worked as a social worker for the Oklahoma Department of Human Services and for the Farm in Kansas.

Ms. Stotts attended the James River Church, in Joplin. She accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at the age of 12; she read her Bible daily and never missed an opportunity to pray for someone or send an encouraging message.
