Maxine L. Brewster, 93, passed away Friday, August 22, 2014 at Windridge Care and Rehab. She was born in Treece, Kansas January 14, 1921 to Burton C. Lewis Sr. and Eula Elizabeth Taylor. She graduated High School in Checotah, Oklahoma. Married her husband, Jake, July 16, 1940 in Miami and gave birth to their only child, Deanne, while Jake left to serve in the war. 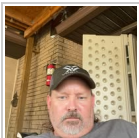

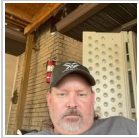
