Nancy Lee (Neece) Garrett died peacefully on Monday, July 2nd, 2018, surrounded by family at her home in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma following a long battle with breast cancer. She was born March 27, 1936 in Ft. Smith Arkansas to George Evan Neece and Eva Lee (Webb) Neece. She is survived by her husband of 62 years, John Charles Garrett, three children; Chandria Garrett-Convey and husband Simon of Vienna, Virginia, Charles Garrett of Wagoner, Oklahoma, and John Marc Garrett and wife Paula of Houston, Texas. She founded Nancy Garrett Realty, which she owned and operated until her retirement in 2004.
