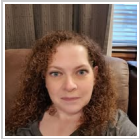

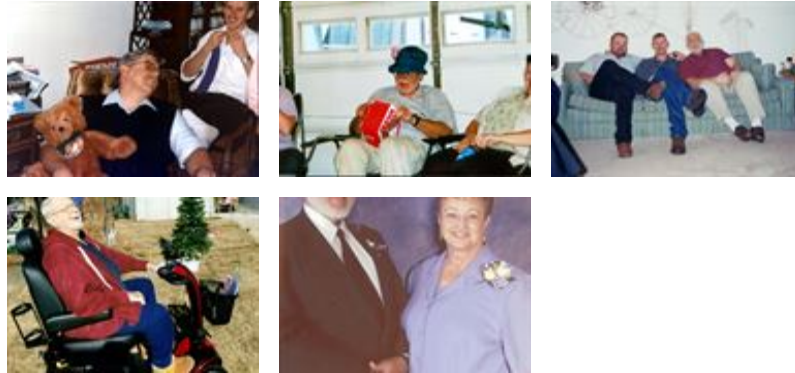

I will always remember his short visits to Safeway! We always had the 1-10 shifts!.lol


