Patricia Ann Cantrell, 84, a longtime resident of Miami, Oklahoma peacefully passed away on Thursday evening, April 27, 2023, surrounded by loving family members.

Pat was born May 18, 1938, in Picher, Oklahoma to James Thomas (Tommy) Smith and Dorothy Valentine (Williams) Smith-Hill. She graduated from Miami High School, class of 1956 and shortly thereafter, married the love of her life, H. E. "Gene" Cantrell, Jr. Being a Marine's wife, she found herself moving numerous times across the country and bravely enduring separations due to deployments and Vietnam. Throughout it all, she was a dedicated housewife and loving mother to her children. They eventually returned to Miami in late 1979 following her husband's retirement and, once an empty nester, Pat eventually found herself at the First National Bank's customer service department where she worked for 20 years, retiring in June 2000.

She enjoyed crafting, needlepoint, sewing, flower gardening, casino gaming and watching a variety of shows such as Judge Judy, Family Feud, and anything on the Animal Planet channel. But, most of all, she loved her children, grandchildren and, most recently, her great-grandchildren. When visiting her home, the first thing you generally would notice was her "Hall(way) of Fame" showcasing dozens and dozens of framed photos of all the "kids" and their special events,

covering the walls, floor to ceiling. In her words, “the word ‘grand’ says it all!”

Pat was truly an amazing and devoted mother, grandma, and great-grandma. It’s hard to imagine a world without her in it. She was beautiful inside and out, a friend to many, and the epitome of class. Although she is missed terribly, everyone should be thankful she is at peace now. She passed away surrounded by love and her family is forever grateful for that.
