Patsy Ann (Wakley) Seawright was born in Nardin, Oklahoma on October 12, 1938. She moved to Blackwell, Oklahoma at an early age. She graduated from Blackwell H.S. where she was involved in band, choir, school plays and was always a member of The National Honor Society. Her college years were spent at Northern Oklahoma Junior College.

She married Doyle K. Seawright on December 14, 1956. Because of Doyle's employment with F.W. Woolworth, they found themselves moving several places in the early years of their marriage. Patsy was one to always work and support her family, and when they landed in Denver, Colorado in 1966 she started working as secretary for The Hoffman Heights Church of Christ. In 1980, she was given the opportunity to work in the Ronald Regan campaign where she was quickly noticed as a "can do" person. During Regan's administration, she was asked to serve in several positions: Some being.....U.S. Department of Fish and Wildlife, U.S. Agency for International Development, U.S. Office of Personnel Management, just to name a few. During her employment, Patsy traveled to Puerto Rico, Guatemala and Canada.

After the Reagan years, and not one to retire, Patsy and Doyle owned and operated a fishing resort in Grove, Oklahoma. She also became a partner with her daughter, Katherine Wilkerson, and opened Everything Grand Gifts in Grove. In her spare time, Patsy loved to fish, bowl, dirt bike and ride on the back of a Honda Touring Bike with the man she loved.

After several years of fighting Alzheimers, Patsy died at home surrounded by her family. She is survived by her husband Doyle Keith Seawright; two children, Katherine Elizabeth Wilkerson and Darren Keith Seawright; four grandchildren, Devan Marie Rameriz, Brooke Ann Seawright, Savannah Elizabeth Wilkerson, Isabelle Grace Wilkerson, Lacey Dawn Wilkerson and son Braden Coer Wilkerson. Her surviving siblings include Peggy Joyce Weaver Morrison, Bill Walkley and Donna Strother, plus all of her loving nieces and nephews.
