Randall F. Dainty, 91, a resident of Wyandotte passed away on Monday, March 13, 2016 in Joplin, Missouri. He was born on August 19, 1924 in Mindenmines, Missouri to Allen and Pearlie (Schoup) Dainty. He joined the United States Navy and was a Seabee during World War II. He spent time in Germany and France, the River Rhine. He was a Mason and Shriner and lifetime member of the VFW.
