Richard Duane "Dick" Goforth was called home after a sudden illness on September 9, 2017 while on a camping and fishing trip in the Colorado mountains. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and loved to be in the woods surrounded by the beauty of God's creation. In November, 2011 he was recognized in the Pope and Young North America Bow hunting Records of White Tail deer for shooting a 16 point buck, weighing 199 lbs.

Dick was born October 16, 1952 in Enid, Oklahoma to Duane and Alice Goforth. He attended Miami High School and graduated in 1971. He was an Eagle Scout during his high school years. He was a jeweler by trade early in life, learning from the expertise of his father at Dawson Jewelry. He earned a Jewelry certification from Texas Institute of Jewelry Technology in Paris, Texas. In later years, he worked as a Truck Driver until he retired in 2014.
