Rosalee Caddell, 96, of Blue Springs, Missouri passed away Thursday, 11 Sep 2014. Rosalee was a loving mother and grandmother. She was born on the 8 June 1918 to Pearl Ella (Tribbel) and Paul Brisco Bostwick on a farm near Guthrie, Oklahoma. Rosalee married Arvil Lewis Caddell in Denver, Colorado and they had one son Wayne Caddell.

In 1943, she moved to Richland, Washington where Arvil worked for General Electric, Atomic Energy Division. In 1950 they moved to a 160 acre farm near Fairland, Oklahoma.

In 2006, Rosalee moved to the Kansas City, Missouri area to be closer to her family.

While in Oklahoma, she was a member of the Fairland Eastern Star, Amaranth of Afton, Jolly Workers Extension Homemakers of Ottawa County (for over 50 years), and the First Baptist Church of Fairland (for over 60 years).

She was preceded in death by her parents, 2 brothers, and her husband. She is survived by Wayne and Jerry Ann Caddell. Grandchildren Lewis Caddell, Ty Ann Salley, Randy Caddell and 9 great grandchildren and 1 great-great grandchild.
